- A free service sponsored by [DreamApply](#) as a contribution to the student exchange community
- Available to the public at [www.dream-agreement.eu](http://www.dream-agreement.eu)
- Able to be integrated into university processes
  - a. Import-Export using special file format (see [JSON schema](#) and [sample](#))
  - b. Create a full integration via API ([API documentation](#))
  - c. Integrated into DreamApply exchange systems
    - Export feature which reduces amount of data entry required

# Demonstration scenarios covered

Because demonstration will focus on using the export feature integrated into EASY the exchange scenarios it will focus on are:

1. Internal sending -> Internal receiving
2. Internal sending -> External receiving
3. External sending -> Internal receiving

and will not cover:

4. External sending -> External receiving exchanges  
(but they are still possible using the tool!)

Note: Many details are populated from the application which means that whatever the applicant enters will be used. However, if the data exist in the system, the application is automatically populated from the profile of their selected home institution. Therefore if the applicant does make changes to these data then they will *ipso facto* come from the system.



# Procedure

1. Locate applicant who is ready to enter into a Learning Agreement
  - a. At this point in time all the necessary data should be in place for Students and Internals
  - b. NOTE: Some external institutions do not have contact information
2. Find “Export” button
  - a. Click on button
  - b. Select “EA: Learning Agreement (dream-agreement.eu)”
  - c. Depending on the mobility the system automatically selects either Sending or Receiving
  - d. Click on “Confirm export”
3. Data has been exported
  - a. Click on “Open in a new window” to view

# Future access of exported agreement

## 1. Via “Export” button

- a. Click on “Export” button
- b. Click on “Open in a new window” to view at [www.dream-agreement.eu](http://www.dream-agreement.eu)
  - i. Since it has been exported it will no longer ask if Incoming or Outgoing

## 2. Via “Eports” tab

- a. Click on Exports tab
  - i. Select EA: Learning-Agreement ([dream-agreement.eu](http://dream-agreement.eu))
