Changes in the system: DONE

- Bugs solved in the Learning Agreement
- 1. The total number of credits does not include the failed courses.
- 2. The checkboxes work in the PDF/print view
- 3. Notification email subject line now includes the correct academic year
- 4. The reason for changes will allow for quick selections from a dropdown menu
- New Status of Application: Arrived and Left
- Suggested Flags: only official names of instruments are available now as suggested flags but you can add more. <u>All</u> <u>old flags not corresponding to official names of instruments</u> have been removed



Changes in the system: DONE

- New optional question on Genre added in the profile section
- Question on the Choice of Professor moved to Profile section:
 the Mobility section of the Application Form will be soon
 inactive



Changes in the system: UPCOMING

- New email notification system
- 1. New notification email for outgoing applications also for internals!
- 2. No more CCs: different emails to coordinators (no danger of clicking by mistake and therefore nominating the student of the partner institution)
- 3. Journal entries will contain the name of the admin who made the offer status change.
- Personal information of applicants from different institutions will be no more visible to other administrators



Changes in the system: UPCOMING

For Students, when applying:

- The "PhD" level has been changed into "Third Cycle"
- Rephrasing of the button regarding the level of study DURING mobility in the first phase of application



POSSIBLE 2021 changes if budget allows

- Automatic flagging (instrument) of the application in Browser
- Erasmus code automatically inserted in the application
- Starting and ending date of semester to appear automatically in LA
- Activation of mobility between internals only possible from the incoming side

Mobility Numbers

Mobility Group 0) up to 15 applications (incoming and outgoing) - for NEW Institutions joining the system

Mobility Group 1) from 16 to 40 applications (incoming and outgoing)

Mobility Group 2) between 41 and 80 applications (incoming and outgoing)

Mobility Group 3) between 81 and 199 applictions (incoming and outgoing)

Mobility Group 4) from 200 applications

Country Groups:

Country Group A) Luxembourg, Norway, Switzerland, Netherlands, Germany, Denmark, Austria, Sweden, Ireland, Iceland, Belgium, Finland, UK, France (coefficient +1)

Country Group B) Italy, Israel, Spain, Cyprus, Slovenia, Czech Republic, Portugal, Estonia, Lithuania, Hungary, Latvia (coefficient 0)

Country Group C): Slovakia, Greece, Poland, Kazhakstan, Russia, Croatia, Romania, Turkey, Belarus, Bulgaria, Lebanon, Macedonia, Serbia, Albania, Egypt, Bosnia Herzegovina, Armenia, Georgia (coefficient -1)

The coefficient is applied to upgrade or downgrade an institution from one Mobility Group to another according to its geographical position

- +1 upgrades to a higher Mobility Group
- **0** stays in the Mobility Group corresponding to its mobility numbers
- -1 downgrade to a lower Mobility Group
