On November 10th 2011
René Arons passed away
at the age of 61. He was not
only a gifted pianist, but also
an excellent improviser and
a beloved teacher.
In tribute to his memory
a contest was organised
in 2015. Now, four years
later, the second edition of
the contest will be held on
February 1st. and 2nd 2019.

Where

The contest will take place in the White Hall of the Royal Conservatory Antwerp (AP Hogeschool), Belgium.

When

Friday February 1st 2019 (Day 1):

- afternoon and evening: first rounds Saturday February 2nd 2019 (Day 2):
- morning and afternoon: next rounds
- evening: concert and proclamation

Who

The contest is open to all musicians worldwide who have not reached the age of 30 on February 1st 2019. Candidates may participate as soloists or in any formation.

Entry fee

Soloist: 25,00 euro. Duet: 50.00 euro.

Trio and larger ensembles: 75,00 euro

Improvisation style

All styles are allowed: strictly tonal, modal, free style, jazz, etc.

The candidate will have to present at least two improvisations, one of which will be an instant improvisation on a given theme.

Amplification

For practical reasons global amplification is not possible. However, individually amplified acoustic/ electric (bass)guitar in ensemble is allowed. In that case the candidate has to provide his own equipment.

Jury

The jury will consist of a selection of improvisation teachers of European Conservatories.

Chair: Yves Senden (AP Hogeschool Antwerpen).

Awards

Prizes (between 300 and 500 euro) are awarded in the following categories:

- · award for the best strictly tonal improvisation;
- · award for the best free improvisation;
- award for the best improvisation on the imposed theme;
- award for the best solo improvisation;
- · audience choice award;
- · wildcard award.

Additionaly, the 'Aronskelk-prijs' is awarded to the most authentic and creative improvisation.

This symbolic award consists of a small sculpture in the shape of an arum lily.

The jury reserves the right to withhold any award in case the required standard is not met.
